Scots All Saints College has recently invested more than \$1.2 Million on refurbishment to the dedicated Senior School and Boarding facilities on Scots Campus, Bathurst as part of stage 1 of upgrades. With more than 150 acres of space for students including a working farm, performing arts centre, sporting ovals and sports facility, indoor swimming pool, and modern, innovative library space, students can enjoy the comfort of a true home away from home with their siblings and family with them.
