



Overseas Students (Full Fee Paying) Fee Schedule 2020

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective from the commencement of Term 1, 2020. The College reviews the fees annually.

Booking Fee \$200 (non-refundable) This fee must accompany the completed Application of Enrolment.

Enrolment Fee \$3,000 This fee is payable upon acceptance of enrolment.

The Enrolment Fee is refundable, upon written application, after the College is satisfied that all expenses incurred have been deducted.

The Enrolment Fee is not refundable if a place is accepted but the student does not subsequently attend the College. If the student leaves without giving the required two (2) terms notice, the Enrolment Fee will be refunded when the two term's fees in lieu are paid.

Table of Fees

The College Boarding and Tuition Fee is an annual fee, which, for the convenience of parents, is charged in four equal instalments. All Amounts are in Australian Dollars (\$A).

A \$50 discount is applicable to the fees if paid on the first day of term.

Technology and Services \$300 per term

Cultural Activities and Excursions \$600 per annum (charged in Term 1)

Health Cover

A 12 month premium of \$516 is payable for student health cover (Medibank Private). Please note that this rate may vary depending on Government legislation. This health cover does not cover dentist consultations. Students are advised to visit their own dentist prior to the arrival at the College.

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New Students

Once an Application for Enrolment has been received by the College, applicants will usually be interviewed. Following a successful interview, an Offer of Enrolment will then be made. The enrolment will be finalised on receipt of the signed Offer of Enrolment along with the enrolment fee and a number of completed forms.

Family Concession

The College grants a fee concession to siblings attending the College simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st Sibling	10%
2nd Sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent Siblings	30%

Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school term. This account includes tuition and boarding, disbursements and technology and services. The term Instalment is **due for payment on the first day of term**. A second fee statement is issued mid term reflecting any further disbursements and any monies outstanding from previous accounts. Outstanding fees are subject to an administration charge of 3% at the end of each term. **The College Council may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding**

Payment of Fees in Advance

An allowance is available to those who wish to pay a year's fee by the first day of term one or a half year's fee by the first day of each semester. The Bursar will be pleased to assist you to take advantage of this offer.

Other Charges

Additional charges will apply for extra subjects taken, including Distance Education and TAFE fees, excursions and other incidentals.

- Uniforms are *not included* in the Tuition and Boarding Fee. Uniform can be purchased at the College's Uniform Shop and must be paid for in full at the time of fitting (approx. \$1,000). Eftpos facilities are available.
- Text books and stationery are *not included* in tuition fees.

Enrolments After Commencement of a Term

When a student commences at the College after a term has commenced, enrolment will be accepted with payment of the Booking Fee and Enrolment Fee, with the term fee being charged at a pro rata rate. Pro rata fees are calculated as a proportion of the annual fee.

Notice of Withdrawal

Two (2) terms notice in writing OR two terms fees are required in lieu of notice given for the withdrawal of a student, except in the graduating term for Higher School Certificate students. When a student is withdrawn after the commencement of a term, the College will refund the appropriate pro rata of the pre-paid fee, less any disbursement incurred, providing the required notice is given.
