

Junior School Fee Schedule 2020

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective from the commencement of Term 1, 2020. The College reviews the fees annually.

A \$50 discount is applicable to the fees if paid on the first day of term.

Family Concession

The College grants a fee concession to siblings attending the College simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st sibling	10%
2nd sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent siblings	30%

After-School Care (K-6)

After-School Care will be available, on request from 3:20pm – 6:00pm. There is a flat charge of \$15 per child or \$20 per family (ie. 2 or more children). Penalty fees will be incurred at the rate of \$10 for every fifteen (15) minutes after that time. After-School Care placements will be at the discretion of the College and will be allocated on a needs basis.

New Students

Once an Application for Enrolment has been received by the College, applicants will usually be interviewed. Following a successful interview, an Offer of Enrolment will then be made. The enrolment will be finalised on receipt of the signed Offer of Enrolment along with the enrolment fee and a number of completed forms.

Students Continuing from Pre-Kindergarten to Kindergarten

For a student continuing from Pre-Kindergarten to Kindergarten, an Application of Enrolment should be submitted. Following an Offer of Enrolment, enrolment can be finalised by paying \$400 (being the difference of enrolment fee from Pre-K).

Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school term. This account includes tuition, lunches, disbursements, technology and services. The term instalment is **due for payment on the first day of term**. A second fee statement is issued mid-term reflecting any further disbursements and any monies outstanding from previous accounts. Outstanding fees are subject to an administration charge of 3% at the end of each term. **The College Council may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding.**

Notice of Withdrawal

One term notice in writing OR one term fees are required in lieu of notice given before the withdrawal of a student.

Lunches

Day students have the option of using the College dining hall every day or bringing their own lunch. A lunch form will be emailed out to you requesting you to opt in or opt out for lunches during the year.

Discounts

The Fee Discount Policy applies only to tuition and boarding fees. No other fees are subject to this Policy. For students in receipt of a Scholarship (Academic, Music, All-Rounder, Pipe Band and Highland Dancing, Agriculture) no further discount will be allowable once the Scholarship, together with any discount has reached 50% of total fees.

Payment of Fees in Advance

An allowance is available to those who wish to pay a year's fee by the first day of Term 1 or a half year's fee by the first day of each semester. The Bursar will be pleased to assist you to take advantage of this offer.

Other Charges

- Additional charges will apply for extra subjects taken, including incursions and other incidentals.
- Uniforms are to be paid for in full at the time of fitting. Eftpos facilities are available.
- Text books and stationery are not included in tuition fees.
