The new location offers an exclusive car park directly through the roundabout on the All Saints Campus. Scots All Saints College Preparatory School has been expertly designed for 4 and 5 year olds.”

Features include modern technology and new resources to provide the best possible opportunity for young children to develop and grow in a caring environment. A new playground with a nature area, bike path, play equipment, vegetable garden and small animal farm ensures a well-rounded program to develop the whole child physically, socially, emotionally as well as preparing them academically.
