



Junior School Fee Schedule 2021

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective from the commencement of Term 1, 2021. The College reviews the fees schedule on an annual basis.

Services \$273 per term

This is a compulsory charge per student for general services, improvements to facilities and technology.

Lunches – Optional for Day Students (no morning tea)

\$420 per term

Day students have the option of purchasing lunches provided by the College dining hall every school day or bringing their own lunch. A form requesting to 'opt in' for lunches will be emailed.

Family Concession

The College grants a fee concession to siblings attending the College from Kindergarten to Year 12 simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st Sibling	10%
2nd Sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent Siblings	30%

After School Care

After School Care will be available on request from 3:15 pm – 6:00 pm. There is a flat charge of \$15 per child or \$20 per family per day. Penalty fees will be incurred at the rate of \$10 for every fifteen (15) minutes after that time. After School Care placements will be at the discretion of the College and will be allocated on a needs basis.

New Students

Once an Application for Enrolment has been received by the College, applicants will usually be interviewed. Following a successful interview, an Offer of Enrolment will then be made. The enrolment will be finalised on receipt of the signed Offer of Enrolment, the enrolment fee and a number of completed forms.

Students Continuing from Prep to Kindergarten

For a student continuing from Preparatory to Kindergarten, an Offer of Enrolment will be made. Enrolment can be finalised by paying \$400 (being the difference between the Preparatory and Junior School enrolment fees).

Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school term. This account includes tuition, lunches (as appropriate), disbursements and services. The term instalment is due for payment on the first day of term. A second fee statement is issued mid-term reflecting any further disbursements and any monies outstanding from previous accounts. Outstanding fees are subject to an administration charge of 3% at the end of each term. The College Council may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding.

Notice of Withdrawal

One term notice in writing OR one term fees are required in lieu of notice given before the withdrawal of a student except in the graduating term for Higher School Certificate students. This notice is also required in the case of boarders becoming day students.

Payment of Fees in Advance

A \$50 discount is applicable to the fees if paid on the first day of term.

An allowance is available to those who wish to pay the full yearly fee by the first day of Term 1. Please contact the Accounts Team on 6331 2766 to take advantage of this offer.

Other Charges

Additional charges will apply for extra programs taken, including incursions, excursions and other incidentals.

- Uniforms are to be paid for in full at the time of purchase (online or at the Uniform Shop) located at All Saints Campus. Eftpos facilities are available.
- Text books and stationery are not included in tuition fees.
