

Junior School Fee Schedule 2026

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective from the commencement of Term 1, 2026. The College reviews the fee schedule on an annual basis.

Services \$633 per term (\$2,532 per year)

This is a compulsory charge per student for general services, improvements to facilities and technology.

Lunches – Optional for Day Students (no morning tea)

Day students have the option to purchase lunch from the Dining Hall on an ad hoc or per term basis via the Flexischools App – see Parent Portal.

Family Concession

The College grants a concession on tuition fees (only) to siblings attending the College from Kindergarten to Year 12 simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st sibling	10%
2nd sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent siblings	30%

After School Care (K-6)

After School Care will be available on request from 3:15 pm – 6:00 pm. There is a flat charge of \$21 per child or \$26.50 per family per day. Penalty fees will be incurred at the rate of \$16 for every fifteen (15) minutes after that time. After School Care placements will be at the discretion of the College and will be allocated on a needs basis.

Parents & Friends Association Contribution

Each year each College family is charged a compulsory \$30 contribution to the ongoing work of the Parents & Friends Association.

New Students

Once an Application for Enrolment has been received by the College, applicants will be interviewed. Following a successful interview, an Offer of Enrolment will then be made. The enrolment will be finalised on receipt of the signed Offer of Enrolment, the enrolment fee and a number of completed forms.

Students Continuing from Preparatory School to Kindergarten

For a student continuing from Preparatory to Kindergarten, an Offer of Enrolment will be made. Enrolment can be finalised by returning the signed offer.

Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school term and is due for payment on the first day of term. This account includes tuition, disbursements and services. A second fee statement is issued mid-term reflecting any further disbursements and outstanding balance from previous accounts. The College may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding. An administration charge of 3% of the outstanding balance is applied to accounts not paid by the due date.

Notice of Withdrawal

One full term's notice in writing, or one term's fees in lieu of notice, is required before the withdrawal of a student except in the graduating term for Higher School Certificate students. For example, a student not returning in Term 1 2027 would need to provide written notice **prior** to the beginning of Term 4 2026.

Payment of Fees in Advance

A \$50 discount is applicable to the fees if paid **before** the first day of term.

Extension of Fee Payments

The College has partnered with Edstart to provide additional payment options for College fees. Edstart is available to families who would like more flexibility with their College fees, including the option to reduce your annual payments by spreading them over a longer period.
