

International Students Fee Schedule 2026

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective for new enrolments from the commencement of Term 1, 2026. The College reviews the fee schedule prior to the commencement of each calendar year.

Enrolment Fee

\$3,000 (non-refundable) This fee is required to be paid with return of offer document.

Fee in Advance

\$10,000 (non-refundable) This fee is payable upon acceptance of enrolment and will be credited to the student account on commencement.

The Fee in Advance is not refundable if a place is accepted and the student does not subsequently attend the College. The Enrolment Fee and Fee in Advance are only refunded if a visa application is unsuccessful – see conditions in Letter of Offer.

Table of Fees

The College fees listed below are annual fees, which for the convenience of parents, are charged in two equal instalments in January and July each year. All amounts are in Australian Dollars (\$AUD).

Student Activity Fee

Fees and services covered in the Student Activity Fee include:

- Provision of IT support and user-pays learning programs and software
- General improvements to facilities
- Cultural activities and excursions
- NSW Higher School Certificate Examination Fee (Year 12 students)

Health Cover

Students must organise their own Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) and provide proof of cover prior to arrival in Australia.

Parents & Friends Association Contribution

Each year each College family is charged a compulsory \$30 contribution to the ongoing work of the Parents & Friends Association.

Concession

The College grants a concession on tuition fees (only) to siblings attending the College from Kindergarten to Year 12 simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st sibling	10%
2nd sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent siblings	30%

Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school semester (January and July) and is due for payment on the first day of semester (Term 1 and 3). This account includes tuition and boarding, disbursements and services. The College may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding. An administration charge of 3% of the outstanding balance is applied to accounts not paid by the due date.

Other Charges

Additional charges will apply for extra subjects taken, including Distance Education and TAFE fees and other incidentals.

- **Uniforms are not included** in the Tuition and Boarding Fee. Uniforms can be purchased at the College Uniform Shop located on the Junior School Campus and must be paid for in full at the time of fitting (approx. \$1,000). Eftpos facilities are available.
- **Laptop is not included** in the Tuition and Boarding Fee. The College has a 'bring your own device' (BYOD) policy. Students bring their own laptop to College and our IT Team will configure the laptop to meet the College system and learning program needs.
- **Camps** (Yr 7 and Yr 9) costs for these camps are approximately \$1000 per camp.
- **Textbooks** cover 2 years (one Stage) of learning and cost approximately \$850 every 2 years.

Notice of Withdrawal

90 days notice in writing or a full semester's fees are required to be paid in lieu of notice given for the withdrawal of a student, except in the graduating term for Higher School Certificate students. When a student is withdrawn after the commencement of a term, the College will refund the appropriate pro rata of the pre-paid fee, less any disbursement incurred, subject to the required minimum notice being given.
